The Prince George Air Improvement Roundtable (PGAIR) is releasing the final version of Stantec's Prince George Air Quality Dispersion Modeling Report on November 30th, 2010 at the PGAIR AGM. The results provide model predictions of the contributions of various emission sources to ambient levels of fine and ultra-fine particulate matter, known as PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5}.

PGAIR would like to provide media with the embargoed report in advance of its public release (public release is November 30, 2010 at the AGM) to provide an opportunity to review the report prior to its presentation at the AGM the next evening. **Copies of the report will be available for pick up at 3:30 at the Railway and Forestry Museum (850 River Road, 2nd floor meeting room).**

We strongly encourage media to attend the presentation provided by Peter Jackson of the PGAIR Research Working Group on November 30th who will provide details and interpretation of the report.
